

## POINT PINOS, NEAR MONTEREY, CALIFORNIA.

Letter of the Superintendent of the Coast Survey to the Secretary of the Treasury, communicating a report of A. M. Harrison, sub-assistant in the Coast Survey, on a site for a light-house on Point Pinos, near Monterey, California.

COAST SURVEY OFFICE, *March 14, 1851*

SIR: I have the honor to transmit herewith a sketch of Point Pinos, near Monterey, California, the site recommended in the accompanying report for the light-house near Monterey, for which an appropriation was made at the 1st session of the 31st Congress; I concur in the recommendation contained in the report. The choice of the site between the three points designated might be left to the engineer charged with the construction of the light-house. (See sketch J, No. 4.)
