Dear Dr. Bell:

It has taken far too long to complete the National Register of Historic Places Inventory-Nomination Forms. Happily however, after many interruptions, the enclosed material is complete, except for need of a U.S. Coast Guard Map of the reservation. The specific copy needed is the one showing a penciled in boundary for operation of the Point Pinos Lighthouse Museum. We have used this boundary as a proposed historic site and the City Engineer has completed a description of the acreage for our use.

The reason for using only the 1.291 acres is that it includes the two buildings of historic merit. All others are far too recent. This was discussed with Mr. John Skinner of National Park Service in Washington D.C. He concurred that the immediate site of the lighthouse would be a logical boundary.

I would appreciate hearing when these forms are sent on to the National Park Service.
