Dear Wayne:

Re our recent telephone conversation that certain donated funds might be available for the Pt. Pinos Lighthouse, the following wish list is applicable:

1. Sprinkler system for landscaping. \$1,500.00.
2. Two hundred running feet of chain link fence for a deer enclosure on the lighthouse property to provide protection for two endangered plant species - Menzies Wall Flower and Tidestrom's Lupine. These are currently in very bad shape due to construction, trampling and grazing. \$350.00.
3. A better parking lot leading to the lighthouse proper. Our present one is of decomposed granite. There is always a good deal of erosion with the winter rains. The current price for hot asphalt is \$50.00 per ton. The lot and driveway will require \$6,000.00.
4. The path leading from the parking lot through a portion of the property is currently decomposed granite, which rather severely erodes during the winter. Because of the nature of the area needing to be upgraded, concrete would be the best answer for a suitable path. This is approximately 100 feet by 3 feet. The cost estimate is \$400.00.

We will be grateful for any help toward the above.
